



Three shepherds were told by the angel of God to be present when their Saviour, Christ the Lord, was born.

In Bethlehem, Mary and Joseph found lodging in a stable. And here, in a manger, the baby Jesus was born.




There was a bright new star in the sky when Jesus was born. And the three wise men followed the star . . .
